# NICU parents find "place of love and comfort" at Gorecki Guest House

In November 2023, Michelle and Nathan Schultz were eagerly awaiting the birth of their daughter, Stella. The pregnancy was easy and uneventful -- until the birthing process.

Michelle labored for 36 hours at CentraCare – Long Prairie Hospital and ended up having a Caesarean section. Braylin, Nathan, Michelle and Stella Schultz Complications at the end of the labor resulted in an ambulance ride to CentraCare – St. Cloud Hospital (SCH) for Stella and Michelle.

Little Stella, born full-term and weighing 7 lbs., 7 oz., had developed Meconium aspiration syndrome. This occurs when a newborn breathes a mixture of meconium (first bowel movement) and amniotic fluid into the lungs during delivery.

This was followed by persistent pulmonary hypertension when her circulatory system didn't adapt to breathing outside the uterus.

After two nights at SCH, Michelle was discharged, but Stella remained in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. Michelle and Nathan couldn't bear the thought of being away from Stella and driving back and forth to their home near Little Falls. They were grateful for the option to stay at the <u>Gorecki Guest House</u> directly across from SCH. For 20 days, this was their home.

"Everyone was so welcoming. It made a crazy, uncomfortable situation more manageable," said Nathan. "Our experience far exceeded our expectations."

"We found a place of love and comfort," added Michelle.

Today, Stella is a thriving, happy baby whose expressions melt the hearts of her parents and big sister, Braylyn. Her parents will be forever grateful for the Gorecki Guest House in their time of need.

The Gorecki Guest House, named after benefactors Benedict and Dorothy Gorecki opened in 2009 and has 28 guest rooms to serve families of patients receiving care in the St. Cloud area.

The guest house relies on donations to offset operating costs and to keep room rates affordable. # If you ever thought about going on a medical mission, read on

In February 2024, we experienced another very successful monthlong medical mission in Honduras coordinating and working with International Health Service (HIS) medical and dental teams. IHS had four medical/dental teams, one plastic surgery team and a team that taught local nurses and performed cervical cancer screening and treatment.

The team I led worked along the Mosquito Coast (northern Honduras along the Caribbean) on the Patuca River where we went by boat to four villages on the river.



When we arrived at each village destination, we set up our clinic spaces, kitchen and sleeping areas in the church or school. About 120 people were seen per day in our medical clinic and about 50-60 in the dental clinic.

Our team's accommodations consisted of individual tents with basic food, including beans, rice, tortillas, vegetables, fruits, and other foods cooked on a camp stove. We had no running water, so we filtered water from streams and brought a generator for electricity to give us light after dark.

Our team included three local translators, two medical doctors, two registered nurses, two general helpers for the medical clinic, a dentist, ham radio operator and two general helpers who worked in the kitchen and

kept everyone fed and hydrated.


It was a great team and a rewarding experience for all!

## Dental Clinic addresses critical need in rural health

The <u>CentraCare - Dental Clinic</u> represents a collaborative initiative between CentraCare and the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry, addressing a critical need in rural healthcare. While oral health is not traditionally thought of as a hospital-based service, patients turn to emergency rooms for oral health issues when they are unable to find dental care.



Since its inception in December 2007, the CentraCare -

Dental Clinic has become a vital resource for the community. The facility is equipped with 10 dental chairs and state-of-the-art dental equipment and offers a comprehensive array of general dentistry services, including examinations, cleanings, fillings, root canals, crowns, dentures, and extractions.

The clinic hosts a rotation of four dental students, one dental therapy student, and two dental hygiene students on a year-round basis. These students provide care under the direct supervision of experienced faculty dentists and hygiene instructors.

Over the years, the clinic has made a significant impact:

- Treated 17,596 unique patients
- Provided 379,406 oral health services
- Trained 1,054 University of Minnesota School of Dentistry students

The CentraCare – Dental Clinic accepts most insurance plans, including public assistance programs, and serves patients of all ages. A sliding fee scale is available for uninsured patients, ensuring that everyone in the community has access to the dental care they need.

This initiative is not just about treating patients; it's about building a healthier future for rural Minnesota.
