United Way of Central Minnesota

In Central Minnesota, more than 400 school-age children experience homelessness and one in eight children is at risk of hunger. These factors impact their ability to learn and develop lifelong skills, continuing the cycle of poverty in Central Minnesota. Through our Emergency Safety Net we make sure the basic needs of food, shelter, and utilities are met so children can focus on their education and not where they will sleep tonight. Through our Education Initiative and Imagination Library we distribute over 85,000 free books every year to children from birth to age 5 to ensure they are entering kindergarten at an appropriate reading level.

The United Way Food Drop is a food distribution event coordinated by United Way of Douglas & Pope Counties through funds raised as part of the United Way Campaign in Long Prairie. Attendees at the Food Drop register, then receive an assortment of food, free of charge. There are no income guidelines for requirements. Without the 38 volunteers, 30 LPGE Student Council volunteers and many partners coming together, this event could not have been possible.

We are so grateful to CentraCare and Coborns employees who financially supported this effort through their United Way Campaigns! Together, we distributed over 6,000 pounds of food to 132 families.
